

MEDICARE DISCLOSURE

According to Medicare Topic #1192, they will reimburse for Physical therapy services based on reasonable necessity as documented in the patient's medical record.

Recertification is required every 30 days from initiation of treatment. In addition, there must be evidence that the physician has seen the patient at least every 30 days.

Because of this ruling, Mt. Stuart Physical Therapy must ask you to authorize treatment of Physical Therapy services, which we believe are beneficial.

I have been notified by my therapist that he or she believes that, in my case, Medicare is likely to deny payment for Physical Therapy services due to noncompliance with the recertification ruling. If Medicare denies payment, I agree to be personally and fully responsible for payment
